We will continue to work hard towards building a strong and sustainable economy that works for everyone!



MAKING LIFE MORE AFFORDABLE FOR ALL CANADIANS

How our government is putting more money back into the pockets of Canadians



Support for Families

 Doubling the GST Tax Credit for 6 months to bring an extra \$234 for single Canadians without children, up to \$467 for couples with 2 children & an average of an extra \$225 for seniors, bringing in an additional targeted support of \$2.5 billion for nearly 11 million households

 Through the Climate Action Incentive rebate, families in Ontario will receive four quarterly payments for a total of \$745 for the 2022-2023 fuel charge year, putting more money back in the pockets of families while ensuring that pollution is no longer free in Canada-

Support for Children

- Providing \$650 per year for the next two years through a temporary Canada Dental Benefit for children under 12, beginning this month
- Slashing licenced child care fees by 50% across the country by the end of 2022 to make child care more accessible, saving families thousands per year

• Launching the **National School** Food Program consultation process to provide relief to over 3 million Canadian school-age children living without access to guaranteed nutritional meals

Support for Affordable Housing

- Introducing a one-time **\$500** top-up to the Canada Housing Benefit to help 1.8 million low-income renters across Canada afford their rent
- Approving the Regional **Municipality of Durham** under the Cities Stream for the Rapid Housing Initiative's third round, meaning it will receive a bulk transfer of funds to build more affordable housing across Durham Region

Support for Workers Increasing the Canada Workers Benefit to put \$2.400 more into the pockets of low-income. minimum-wage families • Increasing the federal minimum wage to \$15 per hour

Support for Canadians with a Disability

• Introducing Bill C-22, the **Canada Disability Benefit** Act to help reduce poverty and support the financial security of working-age individuals with disabilities across Canada

• Introducing Canada's first **Disability Inclusion** Action Plan to implement programs, policies, and investments to improve the lives of Canadians with disabilities

Support for Seniors

- Boosting Old Age Security (OAS) payments for seniors 75 years and older by 10% to provide an additional \$800 on average to over 3 million seniors
- Collaborating with national partners to develop standards for long-term care and allocating \$4 billion to support provinces and territories improve the quality of care for seniors across Canada



Support for Students

- Permanently eliminating interest on Canada Student Loans and Canada Apprentice loans, including those being currently repaid, beginning April 2023
- Increasing the zero-payment income threshold for federal student loans from \$25,000 to \$40,000 for recent graduates



Support for Immigrants and Newcomers

 Implementing the National **Occupational Classification** for immigration programs under the Express Entry system to address labour shortages and welcome immigrants in high-demand sectors such as transportation healthcare and construction.

 Improving processing of permanent residence applications for international graduates, essential temporary workers, and to reunite families

Greening your lifestyle can save you money and our government is helping you do that

- Canadians can apply for the Canada Greener Homes Initiative to access grants and interest-free loans to retrofit their homes and decrease energy bills
- Investing in electric vehicle infrastructure through global partnerships, and introducing electric vehicle incentives for Canadians purchasing zero-emission vehicles so families can save money while helping fight climate change


